How to...make this fluffy sheep c

Follow our easy eight-step guide and make this touchably soft card for a faraway friend!



1

Use your free template on page 93 to trace and cut out the sheep shapes from card. Cut the head from black card, the fluffy body shape from white and a yellow flower.



2

Apply a piece of double-sided adhesive sheet (or tape) slightly smaller than the sheep's body shape, then peel off the backing and cover with tufts of fluffy wadding.

To make the sheep's legs, cut thin strips of black card a few centimetres long and stick them to the back of the body shape with a little PVA glue or double-sided tape.

Position the head shape on the sheep's body before poking two white brads through the head and body, securing at the back. Draw pupils on to the brad eyes with a marker.

Snip out a flower stalk piece from green coloured card using the template on page 93. Glue the pieces together, then stick them in place on the sheep's head.

More inspirations

Sew the softest felt gift tag

Bead up a bookmark!

Cover a circle of card with white beads to make this cute little sheep. Stuck with PVA to a decorated lollipop stick, he makes the perfect bookmark pal!

In pencil, lightly draw a hill shape on to the front of your square card blank. Cut away the top half of the card front with a craft knife, leaving behind the hill shape.

Cover the hill-shaped card front with green polka-dot paper and cover the inside of the card blank with blue card to make a background for your sheep.

Computer print your greeting on white card. Use the speech bubble template to draw around the text, then cut it out and fix it to the blue background above the sheep's head.
